Sandi informed us that the vestry has discussed expanding the cemetery to Three Bridge Road. Betty and Connie noted that this process was started 15 to 20 years ago and that John Rick may have some of the legal information as to the procedures to be followed.

We will have a booth for the Fall Festival on September 24<sup>th</sup>. Details will be decided at our next meeting.

Carroll Barr and Steve have completed the brochure details and it will be printed and distributed at our next meeting.
